PRIORITY 1	Provide youth with HRE leadership, training, and other opportunities to engage in HRE initiatives.
PRIORITY 2	Understand the current priorities, contexts, and initiatives of our individual and organizational members for the purpose of enabling a more inclusive and diverse membership and leadership, including HRE USA's Steering and Executive Committees.
PRIORITY 3	Build members' HRE capacities through training, leadership opportunities, resource-sharing, and the development of collaborative projects.

PRIORITY 7	Creating supportive relationships with individual members to further vision, mission, and priorities of HRE USA.
